WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Eligible students must be:

- at least 15 years old as of the first day of work, and entering at least Grade 10 in fall 2020;
- returning to either high school or post-secondary education in the fall of 2020;
- residents of Prince Edward Island and eligible to work in Canada.

BURSARIES PROVIDED

Upon successful completion of a work term (see below), students will be eligible for a:

- \$1000 bursary if they are returning to high school in the fall of 2020;
- \$2000 bursary if starting or returning to post-secondary education in the fall of 2020.

HOURS and ATTENDANCE

High school students, including 2020 Grade 12 graduates, are expected to work to a minimum target of 250 hours, and post-secondary students are expected to work to a target of 500 hours, in order to qualify for the bursary.

Students will be expected to demonstrate good attendance during the agreed work term.

Unwarranted absenteeism will disqualify students from receiving the bursary.

In light of disruptions to the industry caused by the COVID-19, consideration may be given to student participants who fail to meet their minimum targeted hours in spite of good work attendance and working the hours made available by their employers until the end of the agreed work term. This consideration is made at the discretion of the employer.

PAYMENT OF BURSARIES

Bursaries are paid out to student participants by their employers at the end of their agreed work term. Employers are then reimbursed the government portion of the bursary after submitting payroll information to SkillsPEI.
